**BMO Bank of Montreal Leadership Excellence Award**

Open to all applicants. Please respond to the following question in 300-400 words (maximum) or less typed and double spaced: "How have you demonstrated leadership?"

**Scotiabank Community Involvement Award in Honour of Teresa Melo**

Open to all applicants. Intended to honour a "well rounded student" who demonstrates the ability to achieve strong academic results while exhibiting a passion for community involvement. A maximum of three letters of reference will be accepted evidencing community involvement.

**RBC Dexia FPCBP International Internship Award**

Summer 2012 internship in one or more of RBC Dexia's European offices (London, Paris, Luxembourg or Dublin). \$2000 scholarship at the end of the successful completion of internship.

Applicants should be enrolled in at minimum a 3rd or 4th year university Commerce or Finance program/major with an interest in International Business. Post-Graduate Commerce or Finance students and MBA students are also encouraged to apply.

**Universidade NOVA de Lisboa Award**

Open to all applicants. Universidade NOVA will grant 2 scholarships, valued at 25,000 Euros, to 2 deserving Luso-Canadian students that wish to enrol in any of the three MSc programs at NOVA School of Business and Economics in Lisbon, Portugal. Applicants may choose between the MSc in Economics, the MSc in Management, or the MSc in Finance. The duration of each Masters Program is 18 months, and the Programs are entirely taught in English. The scholarship includes a tuition waiver for the full duration of the Masters and each student will be provided with 5,000 Euros to cover some of the living expenses. Two letters of reference will be required.

1. Original official academic transcript issued by a Canadian High School, College, or University. These must be received directly from the issuing institution and be both stamped/signed and sealed. Photocopies or emails will not qualify as "official".

3. Short biography of yourself, including academic, work and volunteer experience and why you should receive an award.
4. Signed Declaration (please see below)
